Syagen's Guardian™ Explosives Detection Portal is Featured on the Jim Lehrer News Hour

The Company is cited for providing next generation technology

Among those interviewed by correspondent Jeffrey Kaye was Dr. Thomas Chamberlain who ran the explosives detection program for FAA and TSA from 1997 to 2005 and was responsible for funding and developing the puffer machines. He said that one project that should have been more aggressively pursued was a next-generation puffer device. The segment then identifies the next-generation device as Syagen's Guardian Portal and shows a clip of it in operation. Mr. Kaye goes on to explain that the Syagen puffer machine is capable of detecting more chemicals than those currently in use. This is important, particularly for detection of liquid explosives and starting materials that pose a new terrorist threat.

Dr. Jack Syage, CEO of Syagen says, "That the Jim Lehrer production team independently approached Syagen about its superior technology attests to the growing awareness of Syagen's Guardian Portal and the significant performance and operational benefits it offers relative to the current instruments.
